

ALLERGY PATCH TESTING

SHORT SUMMARY

Patch testing is a specialist procedure to find out whether your skin condition is caused or worsened by an allergy to substances that come into contact with your skin. This is called a contact allergy. If your treatment is insurance-funded, provide your insurer with procedure code 20150 for pre-authorisation. An additional consultation with a consultant dermatologist, prior to patch testing, is required. The consultant dermatologists offering patch testing at Montrose are Dr Maham Khan and Stephen Mounsey.

Please note: Patch tests will not detect food allergies.

WHAT WILL BE TESTED

Many thousands of substances can cause a reaction, some of the most common ones include metals. fragrances rubber chemicals preservatives, cosmetics and plants.

WHAT TO BRING

Please bring the following on your first

- A list of your medications: include all prescribed drugs or treatments you are taking. All prescribed ointments and
- creams: Bring any topical treatments you have been using on vour skin
- Your everyday products: Bring items that you use regularly at
 - Toiletries, cosmetics, perfumes, nail products, hair roducts
 - Household products like cleaners, washing powders, or fabric softeners
- If the products are applied directly to your skin, bring both the product and its original packaging, showing the listed ingredients. For household items, only the packaging with ingredients is
- If your dermatologist has requested specific substances, please ensure you bring them to all appointments.

UNSUITABLE FOR

Patch testing may not be suitable if:

- You are pregnant or breastfeeding. You have extensive eczema or other skin conditions on your
- You have used a sunbed or have been sunbathing in the past 6 weeks.
- You are taking oral steroids or other immunosuppressive medications.
 You have applied steroid
- ointments or creams to your back within 72 hours of the

WHAT TO EXPECT

Patch testing follows a strict schedule:

Initial consultation (before testing):

You'll have a face-to-face appointment with the consultant dermatologist to decide which patches to apply. No patches will be applied during this

Monday - Application of patches:

Patches containing the substance to be tested are applied to your back by our specialist nurse. Each ubstance is applied in chambers and held in place with hypoallergenic tape. The location of each patch is marked on your back with ink. Testing may also involve your abdomen, arms or thighs. This appointment typically takes around 20

Wednesday - Patch removal and photos: (48 hours later)

The patches need to be removed and photos of your back taken. You can do this at home with the help of a family member or friend, or you may return to the clinic for assistance. Email the photos to office@montroselondon.com with the subject line: 48-hour patch test photos.

Friday – Follow up consultation:

Return to the clinic for a face-to-face consultation with the dermatologist to review the results and discuss the next steps.

Important notes during testing:

- Itching is normal but avoid scratching the test
- Some allergens, such as pigments or dyes, may leave temporary marks on your skin.
- In some cases, no reaction will appear, which helps to rule out contact allergy as the cause of vour skin condition.

RISKS

Whilst rare, patch testing carries the following risks:

- Persistent reactions: Positive reactions may take several weeks to fade completely.
- Flare-ups: A positive result may temporarily worsen
- eczema. Severe reactions can cause blistering. Pigmentation change: The skin may darken or lighten at the test site. These changes usually resolve within a few months, but they can rarely be permanent.
- Scarring: Extremely rare (1 in 10,000 cases). New Allergies: Very Rarely (1 in 5000 cases), a new allergy may develop due to exposure during testing. If this occurs, your dermatologist will advise you on

how to manage.

DOES AND DON'TS

- Wear old clothing (e.g. loose tops, vests or bras) during the week of
- the testing.
 Sleep in a shirt or vest to protect the patches overnight
- Choose front fastening clothes to
- avoid disturbing the patches Tape down any edges of the patches if they begin to peel off, using the provided tape
 If a patch becomes completely
- loose, remove it, note the time and date, and take a photo of the area for your clinic visit.
- Take a photo of your back if you notice a late reaction, and contact
- Continue to take antihistamines if prescribed, unless advised otherwise by your dermatologist.
- Contact Montrose if you have any concerns or require further guidance.

- Apply any ointments, creams or treatments to your back during
- Bathe, shower or swim during the week of the testing. Opt for a shallow, cool bath.
- Wear your best clothes or light-coloured clothing as the patches and ink markings may ermanently stain clothing.
- Expose your back to direct nlight or artificial light sources, such as sun lamps.
- Participate in strenuous physical activities or exercise, as sweating may loosen the patches.

WHAT DOES A POSITIVE TEST LOOK LIKE

A positive patch test is a red or pink, itchy, often raised area of skin where a substance was applied. This usually disappears after a few days once the

In rare cases, a strong reaction may cause a blister which may last for

On arrival at Montrose, our team will assist in the removal of any makeup. One of our plastic surgeons or dermatologists will undertake an initial consultation to understand any of your concerns and to review your medical history, after which the treatment area will be photographed.

The procedure requires injection of local anaesthetic and infiltration of fluid to the desired area. This enables the easy passage of the cannula under the skin, and radiofrequency energy is then transmitted through the full thickness of the skin to tighten and contour.

Results are at their peak at six weeks, and skin tightening continues to improve for one year. Results last up to five

Once a treatment plan is agreed, the doctor will administer the Botox®, after which there will be a number of small red bumps at the injection sites. These bumps usually settle down within hours and within 24-48 hours, should not be visible.

The effects of the treatment commence within 3-5 days and it is normal for it to take between 10-12 days for the full effect of the treatment to become visible.

We will arrange for a follow up video consultation 12-14 days following the treatment and, if required, we may suggest a complimentary top-up at this point.


